How to Cite a Chapter in a Printed or Online Book, All Contents **Written by the Same Author (s)** **If you ' re using information from a chapter of a book where one author or a group of authors equally share credit for all contents of the book, then you just cite the book** — **there ' s no need to cite the chapter!**

The chapter is only posted online and the pages are numbered from 1, even though the chapter is numbered 13. All the page numbers of the printed chapters in the book (Chapters 1-12) are numbered as expected. Essentially, both Chapters 1 (printed) and 13 (online) begin with page 1.

How to Cite a Chapter in a Book in APA Style **In-Text Citation.** **The chapter you want to refer to will be in a book that has chapters written by a variety of authors. When you refer to the chapter, provide the name of the chapter ' s author(s), rather than the authors or editors of the book. Paraphrase (Author Surname, Chapter, Year) Example**

Chapter in an edited book, reprinted from another book **Use the same formats for both print and ebook edited book chapters. For ebook chapters, the format, platform, or device (e.g., Kindle) is not included in the reference. Do not create references for chapters of authored books.**

Chapter in an Edited Book/Ebook References — **APA Style**

If you want to cite a book chapter in APA format, you need to include the chapter author ' s name either in the introductory phrase before the quote or in the parenthetical citation after it, along with the publication date and page number. For the Reference page, make sure you include the author, chapter title, editor, book title, page range, and publication information.

An **APA in-text citation** includes only three items: the last name (s) of the author (s), the year the source was published, and sometimes the page or location of the information. References include more information such as the name of the author (s), the year the source was published, the full title of the source, and the URL or page range.

Citing a Chapter in the APA Format **Citing a chapter in the APA format is the trickiest part, because edited books are a collection of different chapters from different authors and different books. Even the slightest slip-up can result in you citing the wrong author with the chapter, so it is necessary to be careful to avoid any plagiarism.**

How to Cite a Chapter in a Book in APA Format in Text — **A** —

Basic book citation format. The **APA in-text citation** for a book includes the author ' s last name, the year, and (if relevant) a page number. In the reference list, start with the author ' s last name and initials, followed by the year. The book title is written in sentence case (only capitalize the first word and any proper nouns). Include any other contributors (e.g. editors and translators) and the edition if specified (e.g. " 2nd ed. ").

In-Text Citations **To begin, immediately following a quotation or a paraphrase, APA citation style requires an in-text citation. Typically, these in-text references include the author ' s last name, followed by a comma and the year. You do not need to include the title of the chapter for most in-text citations.**
